Under Section 45(1) of the *Planning Act*, the applicant is requesting the Committee of Adjustment to authorize a minor variance to permit the construction of a new attached garage, ground floor and second floor additions to the existing dwelling on the subject property proposing the following variance(s):

1	Section 5.8.6 b) For detached dwellings on lots having greater than or equal to 12.0 metres in lot frontage, the maximum total floor area for a private garage shall be 45.0 square metres. 2	Section 5.8.7 a) Where a private garage has a vehicle entrance facing the flankage lot line or front lot line and the applicable minimum yard is less than 5.7 metres, the private garage shall be set back a minimum of 5.7 metres from the applicable lot line. To permit the maximum residential floor area for the two storey dwelling to be 36.00% (347.29 m²) of the lot area.


