

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE BY-LAW NUMBER 2022- 012

A by-law to amend Sign By-law 2018-153 (Election Signs and Cenotaphs)

WHEREAS Section 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* permits municipalities to pass bylaws respecting signs;

WHEREAS Sign By-law 2018-153 was approved by Council on December 10, 2018;

WHEREAS Council is desirous of amending Sign By-law 2018-153;

COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The following new definition 20.1 be added to Part 1 Definitions of By-law 2018-153:
 - 20.1 Cenotaph means a monument or memorial to people who died in war, specifically those who are buried elsewhere, that is located on town property.
- 2. Part 1 Definitions of By-law 2018-153 be amended by deleting the phrase "a political party or" from line 2 of Definition 38 Election Sign.
- 3. Section 9 of Part 2 Administration and Permits of By-law 2018-153 be deleted and the following substituted therefor:
 - 9. The Designated Official shall issue a permit if all provisions of this By-law, and any other applicable law known to the Designated Official, including the Building Code Act, the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, Sched, any by-laws of the Regional Municipality of Halton, any guidelines of the Ministry of Transportation for the Province of Ontario and any other applicable legislation respecting sign application or placement have been complied with.

4. Part 10 - Regulations for Election Signs of By-law 2018-153 be amended by adding new subsection 4.1 and subsection 7.1 as follows:

- 4.1 No person shall erect, locate or display an election sign along the frontage of properties where a cenotaph is located.
- 7.1 Each third party election sign referred to in subsection 7(c) shall identify the name of the registered third party, the municipality where the third party is registered and a telephone number, mailing address or email address at which the registered third party may be contacted regarding the third party election sign.
- 5. All other provisions of By-law 2018-153 hereby remain in force and effect.
