4.5 Update on Timber Barns in Oakville

The committee raised pursuing the requirement for video surveillance of vacant properties, and whether the Property Standards By-law would have to be amended to include this in the by-law.

Susan Schappert, Heritage Planner, advised that she would follow up with Legal to determine if video surveillance of vacant properties can be included in the Property Standards By-law, and if there are other alternatives for vacant barns. Ms. Schappert advised that the only way is to ask for video surveillance as part of a heritage conservation easement agreement, indicating that some of these properties are not part of development applications and the timber barns are just simply there on the properties.

The committee was interested in the percentage (proportion) that timber barns make up relative to the heritage elements north of Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW).

Susan Schappert advised that a number of timber barns are located on properties that are part of cultural heritage landscapes, and are not the sole resource on the property. Ms. Schappert further advised that as North Oakville develops these properties will be considered for heritage designation. Staff estimated that timber barns make up a small percentage of the heritage resources for that area, and will follow up on the numbers.

The committee suggested that the wording in section 5(b) For listed properties under Review and Final Decision in the *Notice of Intention to Demolish - Submission Requirements* contained in Appendix B to the staff report be revised to change the word "Town" to "Council" to read, as follows:

"If the OLT decides that the property is to be designated under the Ontario Heritage Act, the **Council** will continue with the designation process by passing a designation by-law."

Staff will make the change to the document and include it in the version to Council for approval.
