## Purpose of application:

Application has been made for Consent to permit a Lot Addition. The application is asking to convey a parcel of land (PART 2) approximately 447.71 m<sup>2</sup> in area with a depth of 46.38 m and frontage on First Street of 9.65 m from REGISTER PLAN 19 LOT 11 to be merged in title with the adjoining property to east described as REGISTER PLAN 19 LOT 12. Approximately 965.96 m<sup>2</sup> of land (PART 1) is to remain with an existing residential dwelling. The purpose of the application is to provide additional land to abutting property to east known as 52 First Street.
