Under Section 45(1) of the *Planning Act*, the applicant is requesting the Committee of Adjustment to authorize a minor variance to permit the construction of a two-storey detached dwelling proposing the following variance(s):

To permit a minimum of 23.5% (8.09 m) of the length of all <i>main walls</i> oriented toward the <i>front lot line</i> to be located within the area on the <i>lot</i> defined by the <i>minimum</i> and <i>maximum front yards</i> .
5	<b>Section 6.4.6 c)</b> The maximum <i>height</i> shall be 9.0 metres.	To permit a maximum <i>height</i> of 10.95 metres.
