- Our approach will be positive and collaborative, with a focus on achieving measurable outcomes to the community.



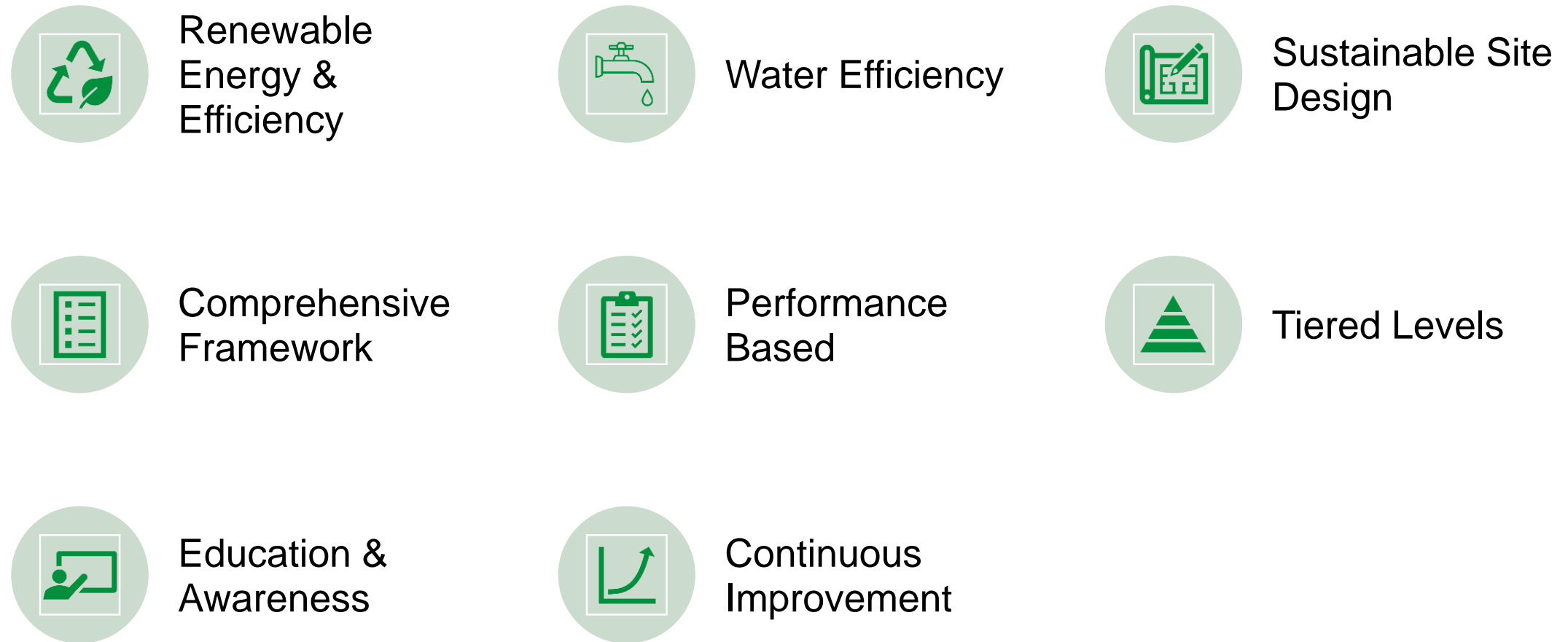

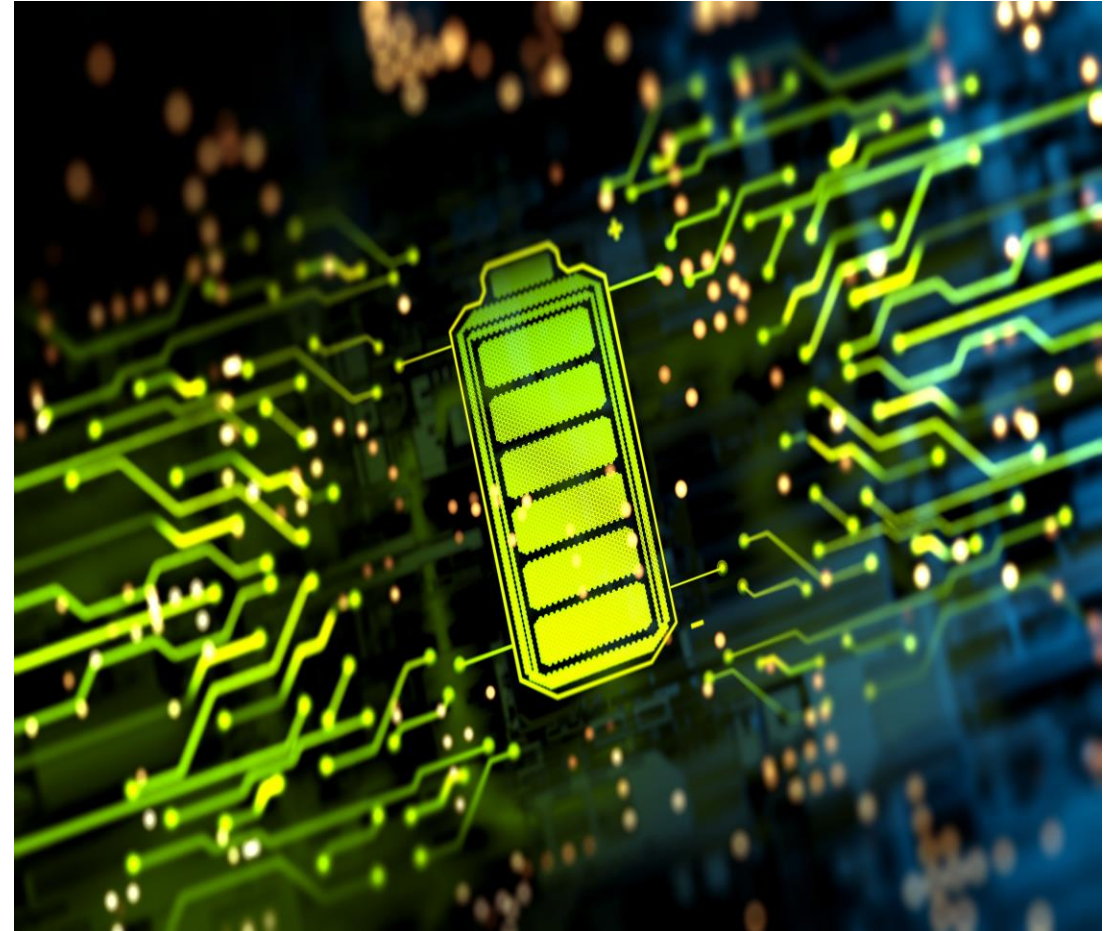
