Appendix C - A by-law to amend Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Violations and Orders By-law 2021-038.docx

WHEREAS Section 127 of the Municipal Act, provides that a municipality may require the owner or occupant of property to clean and clear the property, not including buildings, or to clear refuse or debris from the property; not including buildings;

WHEREAS subsection 434.1(1) of the Municipal Act provides that a municipality may require a person, subject to such conditions as the municipality considers appropriate, to pay an administrative penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a by-law of the municipality passed under this Act;

WHEREAS the Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Violations and Orders Bylaw 2021-038 was approved by the Council for the Corporation of the Town of Oakville (the "Council") on February 22, 2021 and Lot Maintenance By-law 2023-075 was approved by Council on June 19, 2023;

WHEREAS Council is desirous of amending the Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Violations and Orders By-law 2021-038 and Lot Maintenance By-law 2023-075, as set out in this By-law;

COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1.1 Application of this By-law of Administrative Penalties for Non-Parking Violations and Orders By-law 2021-038 is hereby amended by adding the following:
 - (u) Kite Fighting By-law 2023-105
- 2. Lot Maintenance By-law 2023-075 is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) delete the definition of kite fighting string from Section 1 Definitions;
 - (b) delete subsections 5(14) and 5(15) from Section 5 Property Maintenance.
