2014-2019	Patio Pilot Program	<p>construction mitigation initiative</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • within BIAs for patios on municipal land on boulevards and on-street parking spaces • encroachment agreements executed • processing fees collected • fee to use parking spaces waived <p>Participation: participation increased to total of 22 patios and distributed between the BIAs</p>
2020-2022	Commercial Recovery Initiative (CRI)	<p>COVID response and recovery initiative</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • patios on municipal land (road corridors) and private commercial sites • encroachment agreements (public) and user agreements (private) executed • all fees waived <p>Participation: (in BIAs + private sites town wide) 2020 – 35 (public) + 40 (private) = 75 patios* 2021 – 56 (public) + 56 (private) = 112 patios* 2022 – 53 (public) + 35 (private) = 88 patios*</p> <p>* 'patios' includes patios, bistros, outdoor merchandising, outdoor activities (gyms), etc.</p>
2023	Transitional Year	<p>continuation of the CRI program permissions during the development of a seasonal program</p> <p>Participation: (in BIAs + private sites town wide) 2023 – 60 (public) + 14 (private) = 74 patios</p>
2024 +	Seasonal Program (permanent strategy)	To be developed in 2023 for launch in spring 2024.
