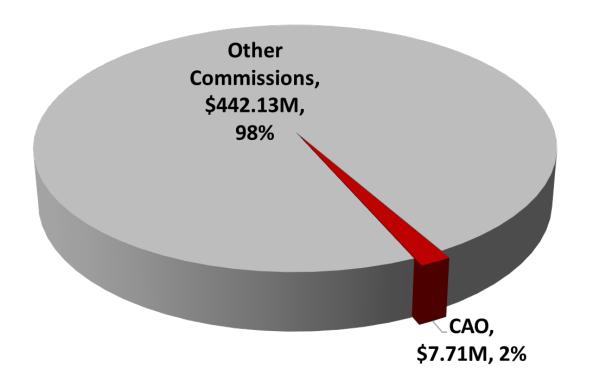

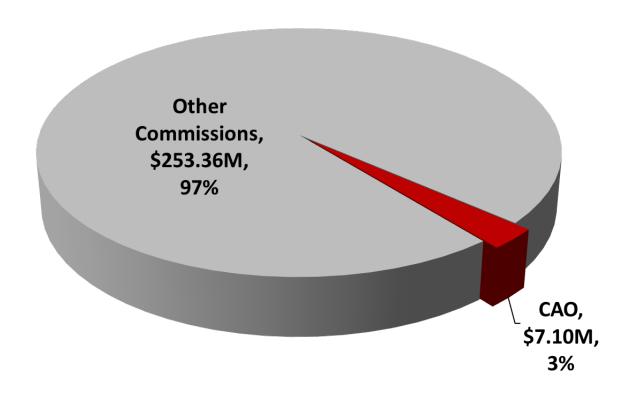

#### 2024 Gross Operating Budget \$7.71M

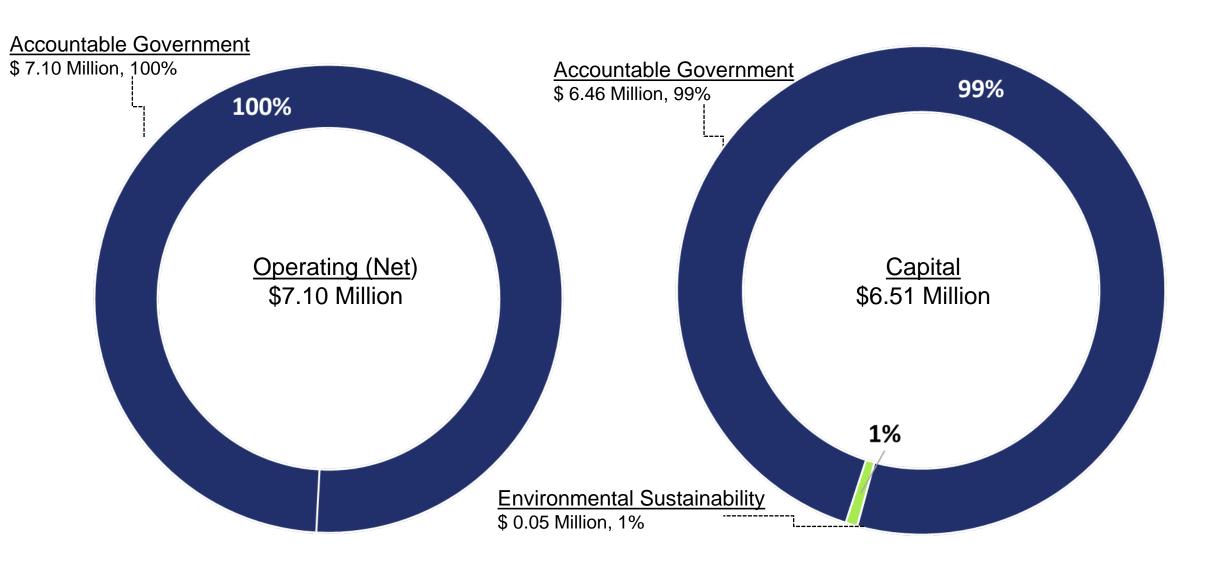
# 2024 Net Operating Budget \$7.10M

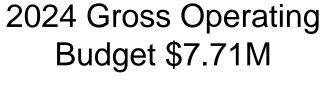

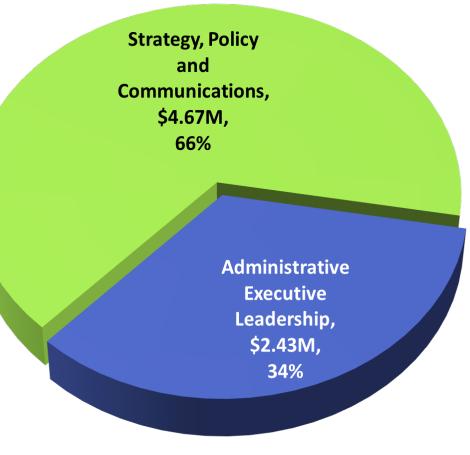

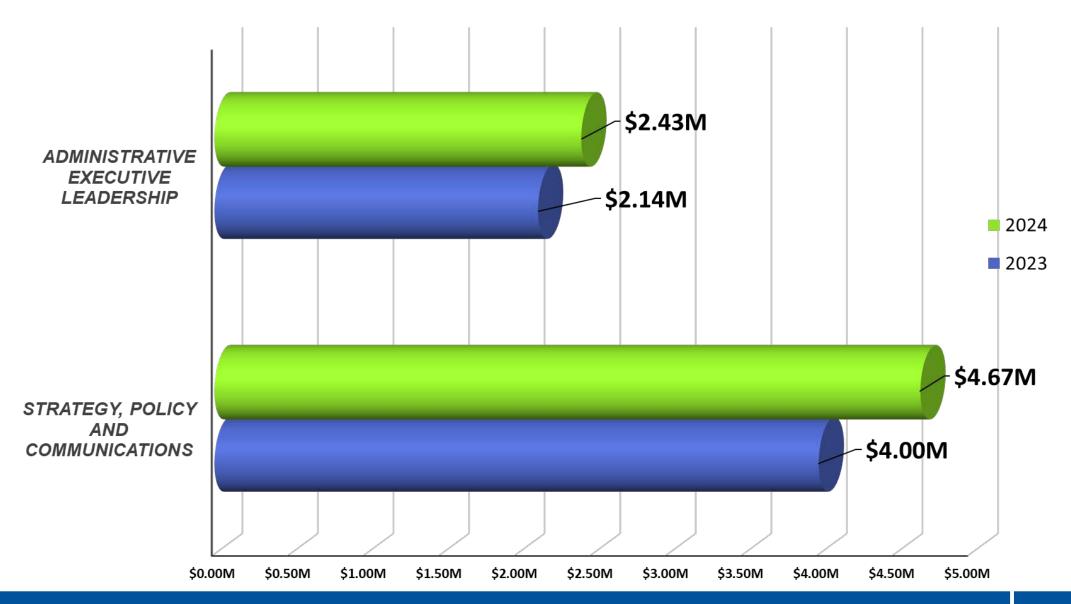


#### 2024 Net Operating Budget \$7.10M

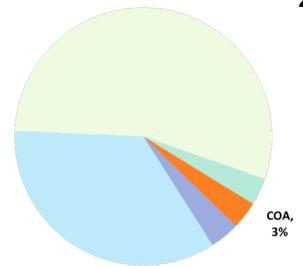

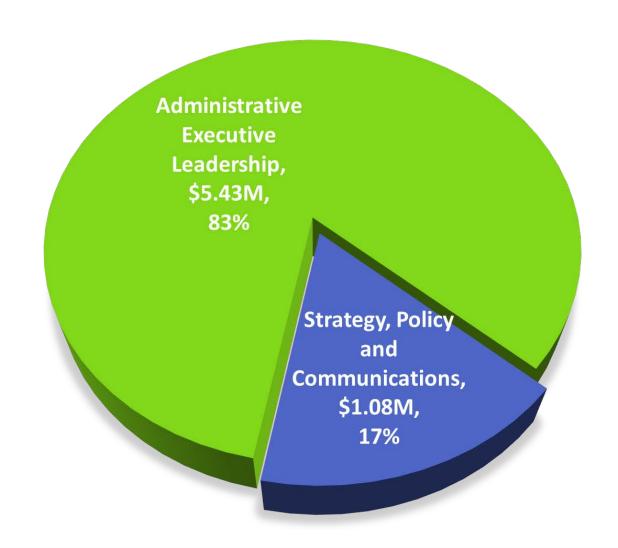


# **Capital Budget Overview**
