Comments

At the meeting of December 14, 2023, follow up was requested from the committee on the following items:

Transit (Re: Item 3.1)

- An inquiry was made by a member of the length of time it takes for a specialized application to be processed, statistics for 2023 provided below:

Oakville Transit's average processing time of specialized applications for each quarter of 2023 are as follows:

1st quarter: 5 days 2nd quarter: 3.5 days 3rd quarter: 3 days 4th quarter: 3 days

It is important to note that we are required under AODA to process applications with 14 business days upon receipt.

- It was noted in minutes that there is a process for deficiencies if a transit vehicle is not operating as expected. An inquiry was made by a member of how often drivers are recording equipment as non-functioning.

In 2023, there were 3 instances of vehicles being recorded as having nonfunctioning audio and/or visual announcements.

- How Applications are Assessed. Staff review all site plan applications to ensure
 the proposals conform to the universal design direction, accessibility requirements,
 and technical standards outlined in the <u>Livable by Design Manual</u> and the <u>Site Plan</u>
 <u>Design & Development Standards</u>.
- Consultation with AAC. Staff will continue to consult with AAC on:
 - all new and updated accessibility-related planning policies, urban design direction and standards manuals,
 - o emerging current planning issues associated with accessibility, and
 - all proposals for town facilities and capital projects.
- Viewing Site Plan Applications. All site plan applications submitted to the town are posted to the <u>Active Development Applications</u> pages the town website <u>oakville.ca</u>. Staff prepared a step-by-step reference sheet (**Appendix A**) for accessing and viewing site plan files online.
