


### Zara's on Wheels Food Trailer Cover Letter

Zara's on Wheels is a food trailer for take out <u>only</u>. The Trailer is located at private property, Bronte Legion parking lot located at 79 Jones Street, Oakville.

The property has an occupancy of 79 people with 60 parking spaces. The trailer is occupying one parking space only out of 60, on the side of the property, where it is not interfering with any traffic in the parking lot.

79 Jones Street property (the Legion) has their own zoning permit on site, however the Legion is no longer using their kitchen as they are not able to find volunteers to run the kitchen and cook food on a daily basis for the legion visitors.

This is why we are seeking a variance to supply them with food from the trailer outside.

The food trailer has been an asset to the Legion and Bronte area, as the business name is well known in the area. Before opening the food trailer, I had a restaurant under the same name in the same neighbourhood in Bronte for over 15 years. We have a great reputation and loyalty from the neighbourhood where Zara's has been part of the community for a very long time.


When we closed down the restaurant (Zara's by the Lake), it was a big disappointment for the neighbourhood, it was well evidenced by the social media reaction and the news published on "Inside Halton.com" where they wrote about us and the value we brought to the area.

We were encouraged by the BIA and the Legion to open the same type of food as take out from the trailer. The BIA supported by funding the painting of the trailer, where it was painted by a local artist to symbolize Bronte and the Lakehouse. The trailer became a known place to visit in Bronte.

My business contributes to the community by participating and donating to many event, for example last November I cooked and donated 300 hotdogs to thank the wonderful Cadets at the Bronte Legion in Remembrance Day. For over a month in cold weather I donated over 1500 free bowls of soup to the neighbourhood. Our business also donates food to the people in need in the area.

Having the food trailer in the Legion area has been a great asset since all the loyal customers who used to visit the restaurant became regular visitors to the trailer and to the Legion.

# 'GREAT SADNESS': Well-known Oakville restaurant permanently closing and customers are expressing disappointment

Owners shifting gears to a food truck location not far from the original spot

A well-known restaurant in Oakville is closing and its owners are taking on a new adventure.

Zara's By The Lake, a Mediterranean restaurant that's been a staple in Bronte for years, is shutting down Saturday (May 27).

"It is with great sadness to announce the closure of Zara's by the Lake restaurant by Saturday May 27. After nearly 17 years in the business, my family and I have decided to close the doors of our restaurant and start a new adventure," the owners said in a Facebook post. "The success we had all these years derived from the immense support of the community and our loyal customers. We wouldn't be here without you. My wife, kids and I have shared memories, laughs and moments with you that are unforgettable. You have made our dream come true. You have contributed greatly and amazingly to our local business. The gratitude we owe you is enormous."

This Facebook post is no longer available. It may have been removed or the privacy settings of the post may have changed.

The owners are now shifting to a new adventure; a food truck called Zara's on Wheels, at a new location at 79 Jones Street (near Bronte Legion).

"You will still be able to enjoy the same menu through our new location," the owners said.

Zara's has long been known for their shawarma, gyros and souvlaki dishes, receiving a 4.6 rating on Google with more than 200 reviews.

"Oh that is such sad news," Judy Magnus said on Facebook. "Good luck on your new adventure but your restaurant will be sorely missed."

Linda Campbell added, "so happy for you, so sad for us."



To Whom It May Concern,

We, the Bronte Business Improvement Area (BIA), would like to express our support for the Minor Variance application for Zara's On Wheels, located at 79 Jones Street in Oakville.

The reasons for our support are as follows:

- 1. Zara's On Wheels operates on the property of the Bronte Legion at the *request* of The Legion. This organization is a vital community gathering space for connection, fun and celebration and has a calendar of events that brings veterans and members of the local community together five or more days weekly. Zara's On Wheels is an amenity that adds to the vibrancy of The Legion and enhances what is already a similar usage of the property. To answer the question is the variance desirable for the appropriate use of the land? the answer is *yes*.
- 2. Bronte is a designated Tourism Destination with a waterfront that is celebrated by residents and visitors. The neighbourhood features vibrant businesses and community and cultural uses at street-level. Zara's On Wheels enhances the visitor experience by creating a unique and accessible way to enjoy the local food scene, adding to the overall vitality of the commercial district. We believe that the Minor Variance application needs to be evaluated in the context of what is in the best interest of a Tourism Destination.
- **3.** Mel Jabr, owner of Zara's On Wheels, has operated in Bronte in the food service sector for 17+ years. He is a beloved member of the local community and his foray into the food truck industry has had great support from local businesses and residents. He is an engaged member of our business improvement association: (1) inviting the BIA to lead a public art project using his food truck as a canvas (see Appendix A) and (2) often

**4.** At present, Bronte is undergoing a transformation that will see four major redevelopment projects unfold in the coming months and years. While this revitalization is much-needed, the construction will be challenging for local businesses. Zara's On Wheels animates and brings colour to the neighbourhood (see Appendix A) and creates a unique experience for visitors. Both of these contributions are significant, as they mitigate the impacts of construction.
