Back in 2017, we talked about "the magnitude of the Glen Abbey proposal and its potential impact on the community warranted further study."



Interim Control By-law used for Glen Abbey but not Midtown?

Glen Abbey (92.7 hectares) **saved from** the developers **8-10,000** Midtown (43 hectares) **offered to** the developers **60-80,000**
