Lack of Public Engagement

Negates any goodwill generated by recent Bronte Streetscaping PIM's
The staff report does not address why there was **no public engagement**
Yet **concludes** their report by stating that **public is not affected**

A Designated Heritage Building

Any significant changes or any modifications would **merit public engagement**
The **current and continued uses** of boat storage **diminishes the historical value**
Severely **restricts its potential** for any future use. Been vetted by **Heritage Oakville?**

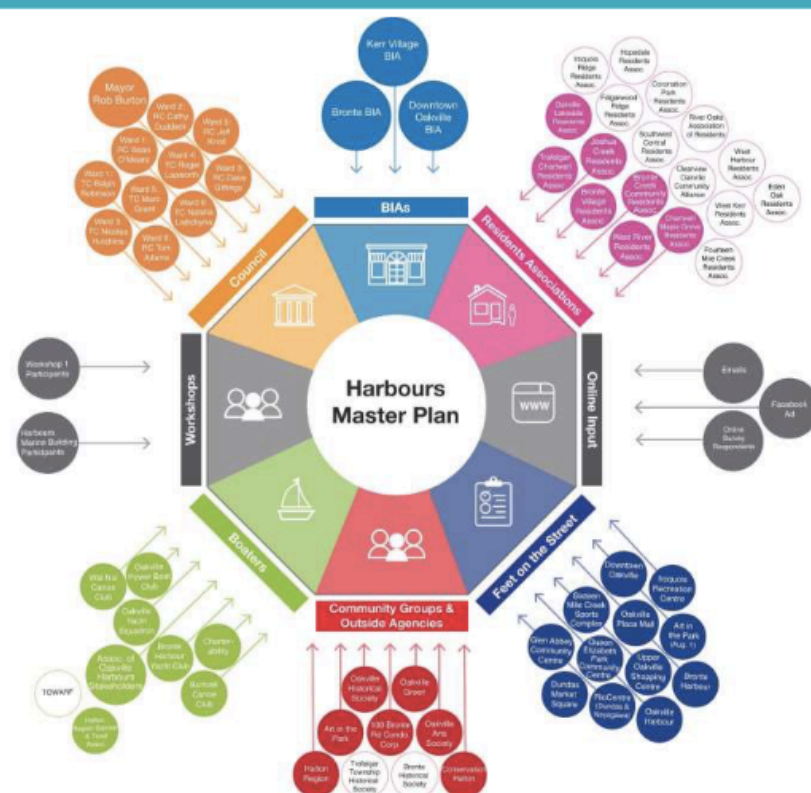

Harbours Master Plan

What is it?

- In a coordinated vision for the future, the town initiated a study to develop a **Harbours Master Plan** that, for the first time, includes all harbour areas – Bronte Inner and Outer Harbours and Oakville Harbour.

- Update to Oakville Harbours Financial Strategic Business Plan, including recommendations for the future use of the Bronte Marina Building
