Indigenous Knowledge Guide

OPL is excited to partner with Stephen Paquette as a local Indigenous Knowledge Guide, supported by the Government of Canada's COVID recovery grant. Over the years, Stephen has been recognized by local Indigenous and non-Indigenous community and municipal leaders as a trusted and knowledgeable educator/guide in supporting Truth and Reconciliation work across Halton. Stephen will assist OPL strengthen the foundation of knowledge and systems to be based on Indigenous ways of knowing and being, in three areas: internal staff initiatives and programs, external customer engagement; and in consultation for the New Central Project.

New Central Project

- October 2 Public Open House @ Central 5-8pm

Targeted Engagement:

- Community Organizations 3 focus group sessions
- Teens focus group with OPL's Youth Library Leader groups
- Children/Families OPL will be incorporating consultation into 6 different programs for School Age children in Sept/Oct across the system
- Donors hosting a private donor/prospective donor event
- Indigenous consultation small group sessions
- Sessions with Town of Oakville Council members
- All Staff workshop as part of the upcoming Staff Development Day on September 20th.

A report highlight key learnings from the public consultation is expect to come to the board at the November 21st meeting.
