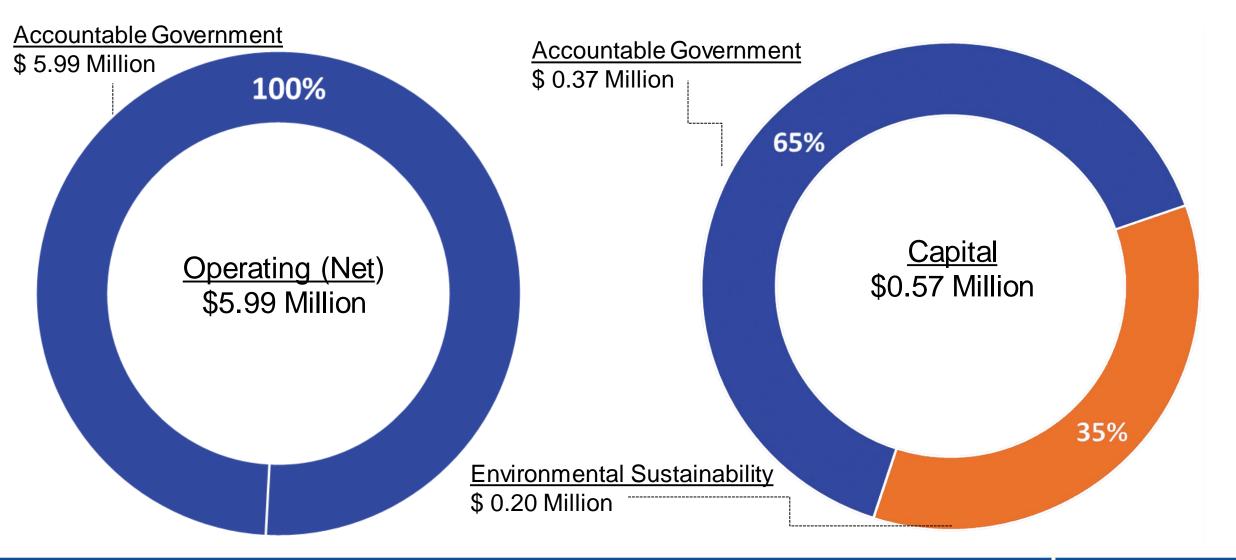

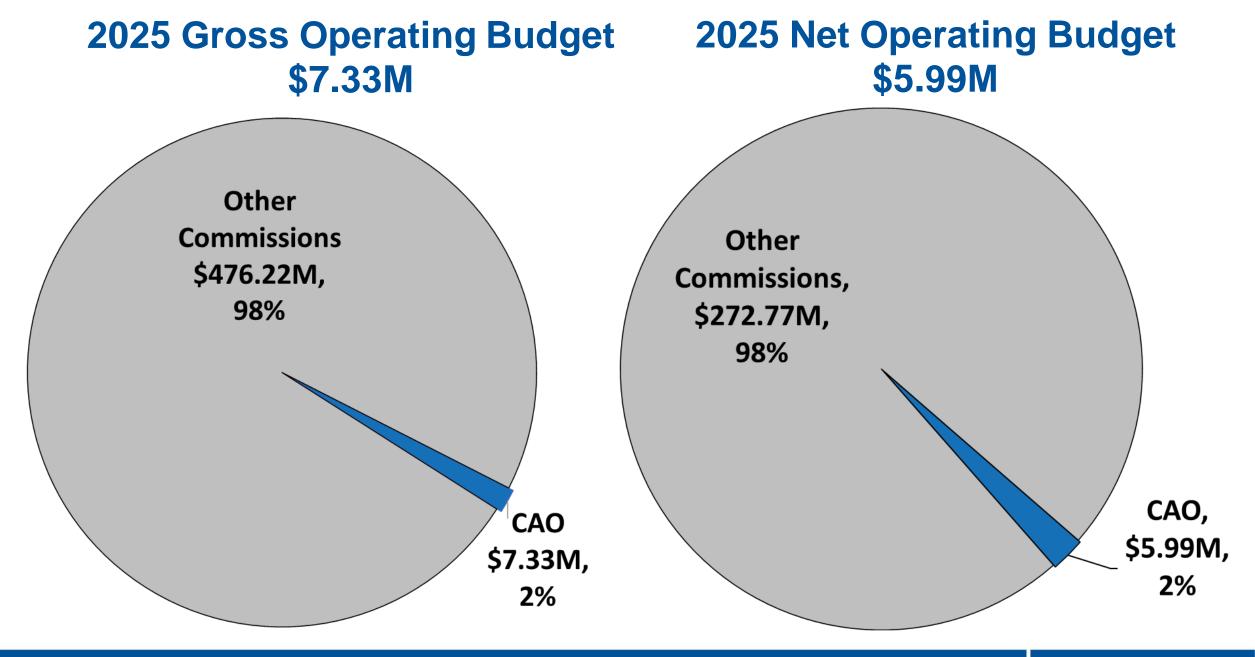


2025 Budget By Council Strategic Priority





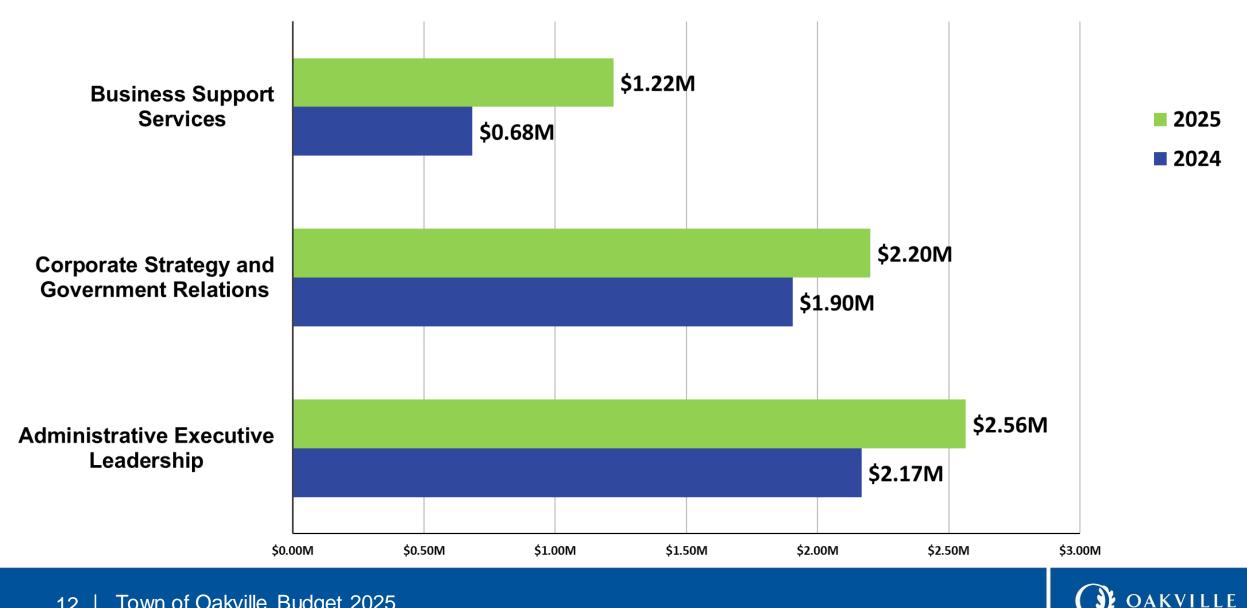








2025 Tax Levy by Program







New operating funding in 2025 Budget

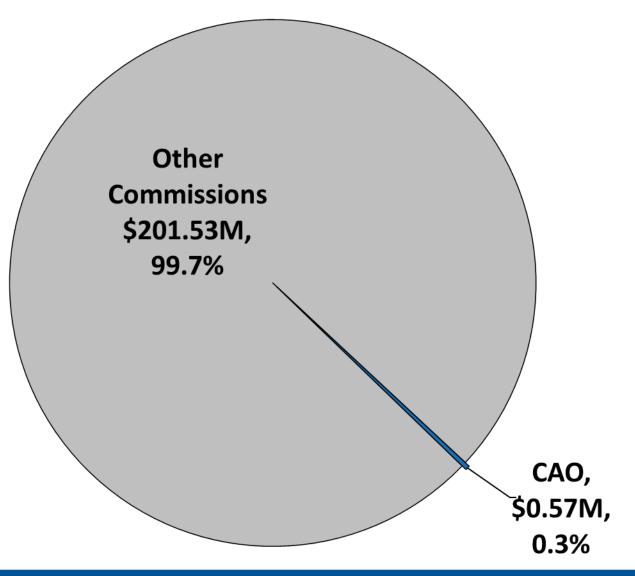
- Business Support Services

Capital Budget Overview

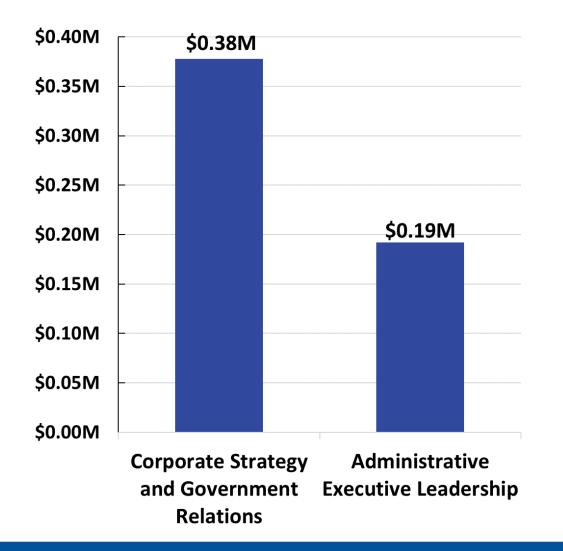


2025 Capital Budget, \$0.57M
