Traffic Congestion

- PROBLEM: Already serious congestion at the Oakville
 Go and in key Midtown approaches at rush-hours
 - PROBLEM: Oakville population forecast to double in the next 27 years; congestion shrugged-off as "continuing to exist in the future"

Is nightmare congestion throughout Oakville what we want?



• ASK of COUNCIL: Elevate importance of this issue

Pedestrian and Cyclist Safety

- **PROBLEM:** Scope Constraints
- PROBLEM: No separation of vehicles, pedestrians and bikes in key approaches to the west and south of Midtown boundaries



 ASK of COUNCIL: Include resolution in Midtown scope

Parking

- PROBLEM: Vision of Midtown as an urban enclave where residents walk or take transit and do not own cars
- PROBLEM: Vision of limited or no surface parking within new developments
- ASK of COUNCIL: Address parking issue



Metrolinx

- PROBLEM: Metrolinx has its own agenda
- ASK of QUEEN'S PARK: Metrolinx engagement
- ASK of COUNCIL: Adjust Midtown OPA to accommodate Metrolinx's plans
