Hello

I have the following comments on the new noise bylaw, specifically wrt backyard music.

The changes (as I understand them):

- Old Bylaw 55 dBA measured at the property line until 5pm
- New Bylaw 50 dBA measured 3m from the house until 7pm.

I have the following concerns:

- The allowable noise level has been reduced from 55 to 50 dBA in conjunction with extending the time to 7pm. While this seems like a reasonable compromise the POR has been moved much closer to the house.

- If one has a larger property the new POR completely eliminates the mitigating effects of distance from adjacent properties.

- An upset neighbour can play his music loudly to achieve 50 dBA at the POR of a noisy neighbour. The area in between becomes a virtual war zone upsetting the peace for all.

- Measurement/enforcement requires a qualified attending officer with noise meter to potentially enter multiple properties.
