

Background

- The Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District has been in place since 1982.
- Update process started in 2021: two
 major components
 - District Study
 - District Plan and Guidelines
- In February 2024, Council approved the District Study
- In February 2025, the statutory public meeting for the District Plan and Guidelines was held at Planning & Development Council
- Heritage Oakville Advisory Committee has endorsed the District Plan and new bylaws





Engagement


- Extensive community and stakeholder engagement:
 - Numerous individual stakeholder meetings and site visits
 - Four Public Information Meetings
 - Regular updates to the Heritage Oakville Advisory Committee
 - Three appearances before Planning and Development Council
- Statutory Public Meeting February 3, 2025
- Required Heritage Oakville Advisory Committee consultation: February 25, 2025
- Additional revisions addressed in memo dated March 17, 2025



By-Laws

- By-law 1981-144 be amended to adjust the mapping to show those properties now included within the Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District through By-law 2025-054.
 - Boundaries of the HCD are only changing to include the previously excluded Part IV designated properties, which is now permitted through section 41 (2) of the Ontario Heritage Act
- By-law 2025-063 adopts the Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District Plan and Guidelines under subsection 41.1 (2) of the Ontario Heritage Act.
 - District Plan and Guidelines meet all the requirements of Part V of the Act and staff are confident that it is a defendable and reasonable plan for the management of heritage resources in the Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District.







Staff recommendation:

- That By-law 2025-054, a by-law to amend By-law 1981-144, a by-law to designate an area of the Town as a Heritage Conservation District under Section 41(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, to include Part IV properties at 8 Navy Street, 110-114 King Street and a Portion of 144 Front Street, be passed; and report titled "Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District – Statutory Public Meeting", be received.
- That By-law 2025-063, a by-law to adopt the Old Oakville Heritage Conservation District Plan and Guidelines dated March 2025 under subsection 41.1 (2) of the Ontario Heritage Act, be passed.
