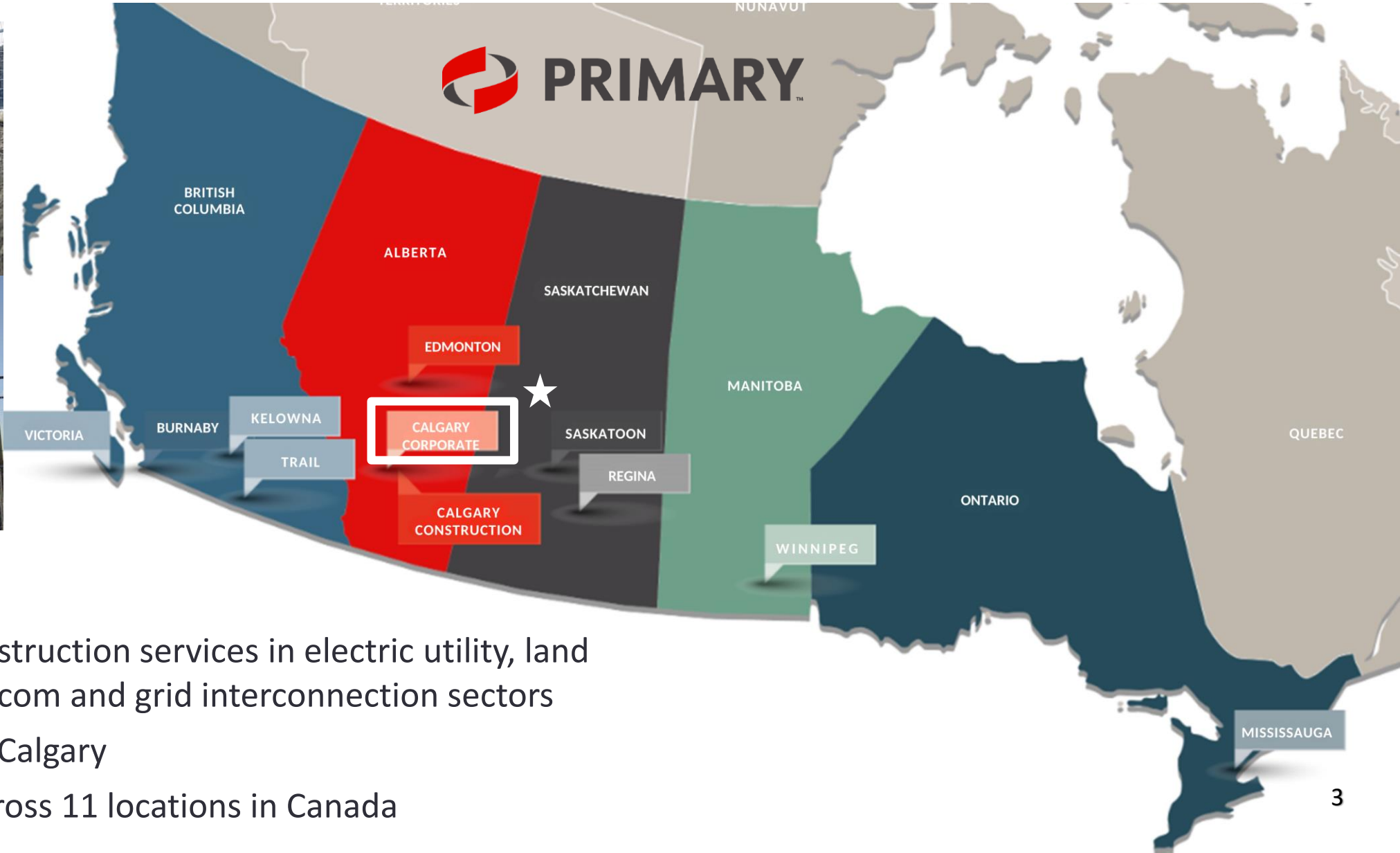

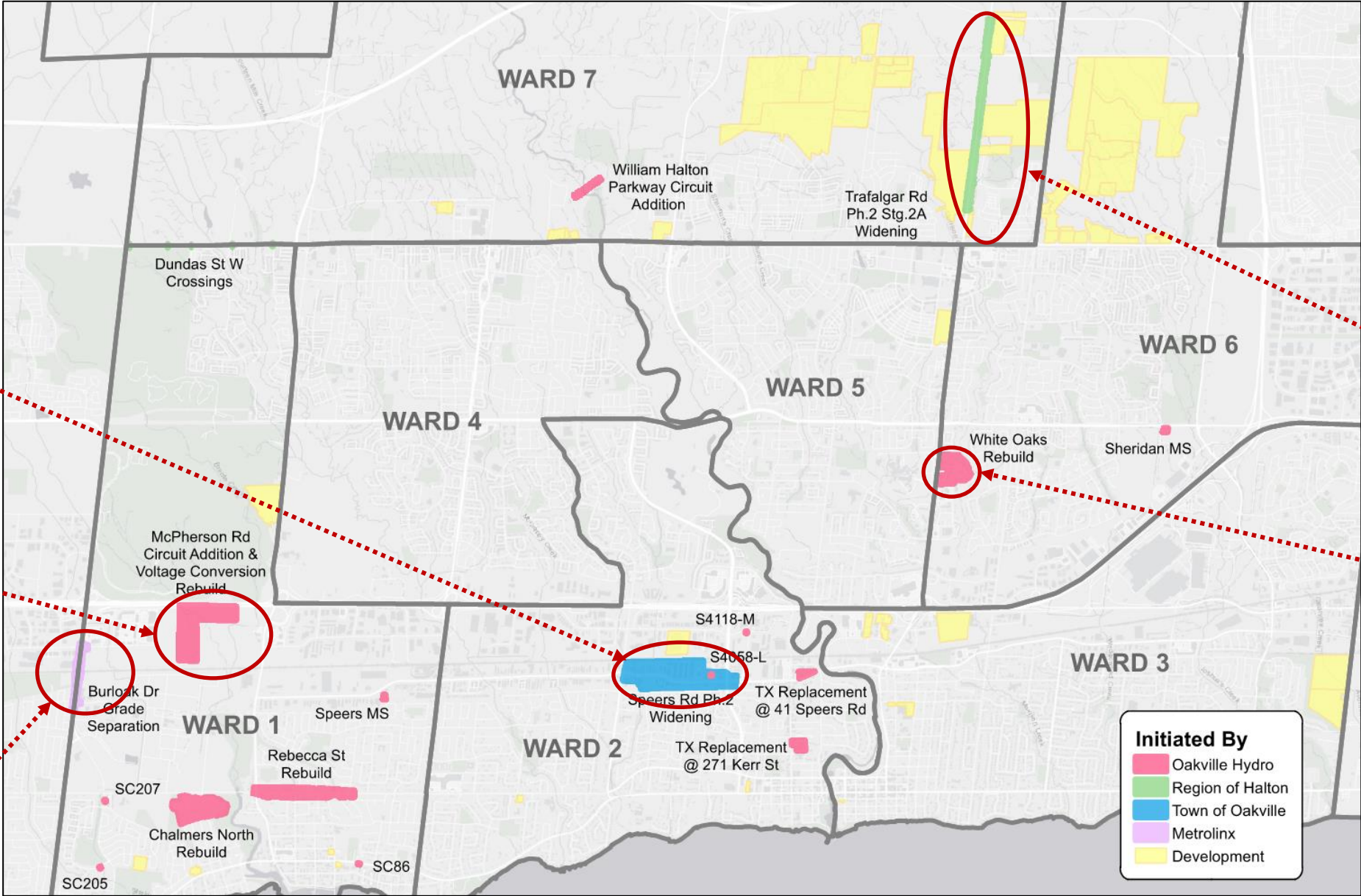
# OEC Announces Majority Ownership of Primary Engineering & Construction

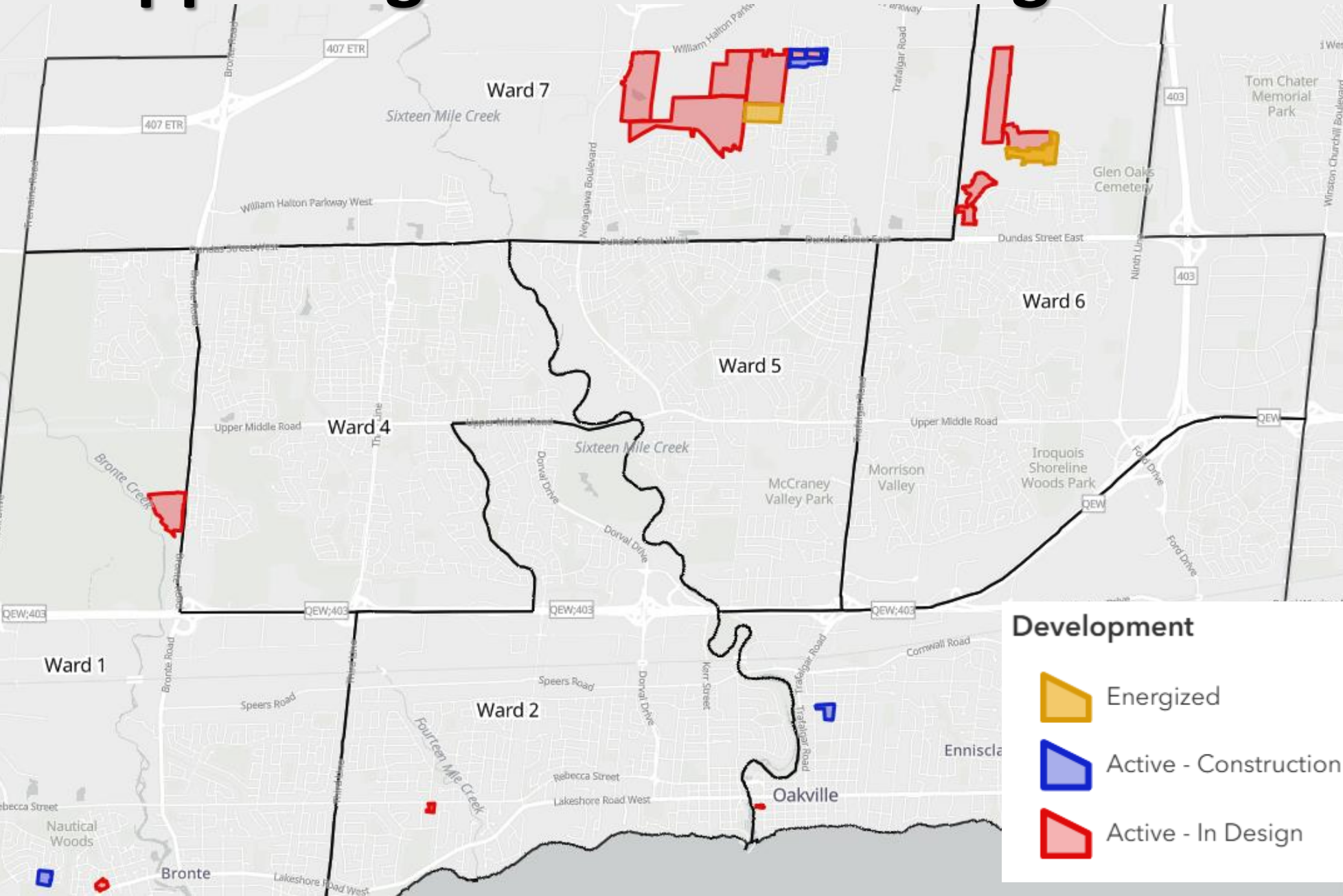

- 1,350 new meter connections expected



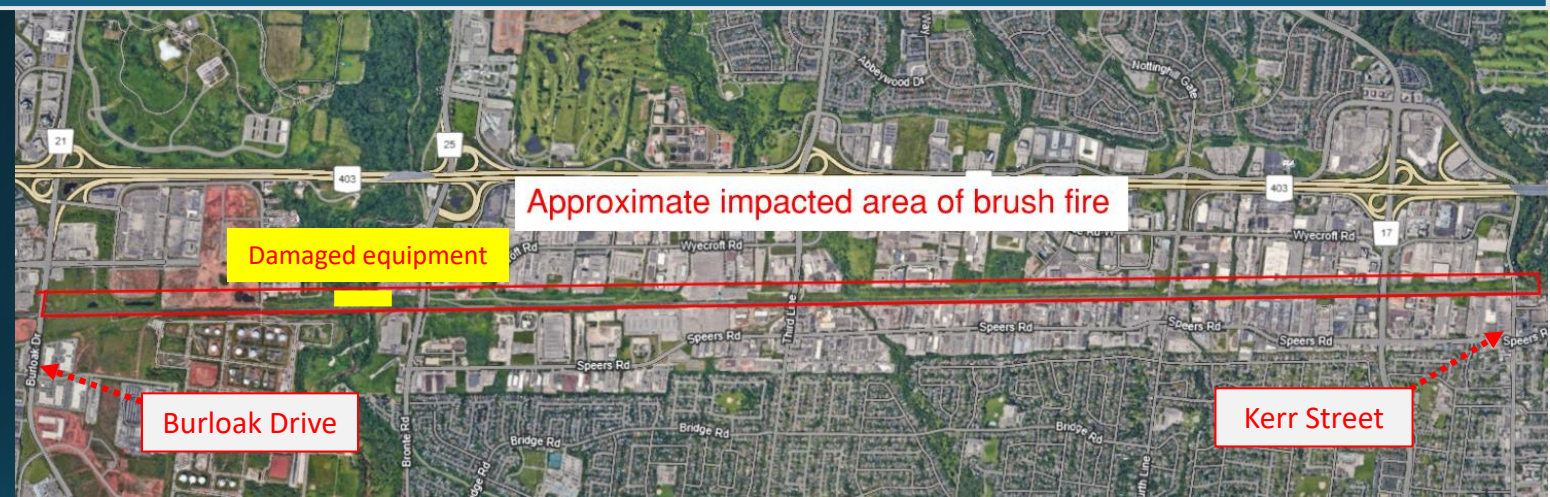


Damage to poles and H-Frame structure at the Bronte Creek Crossing

# Low-income Energy Assistance Program

- Low-income energy assistance program (LEAP) provides financial support to eligible individuals having difficulty paying their electricity bills
- In 2024, \$85,000 was provided to 178 households in Oakville



# Demand Side Management Program

- Receive timely updates on government incentives to support your transition



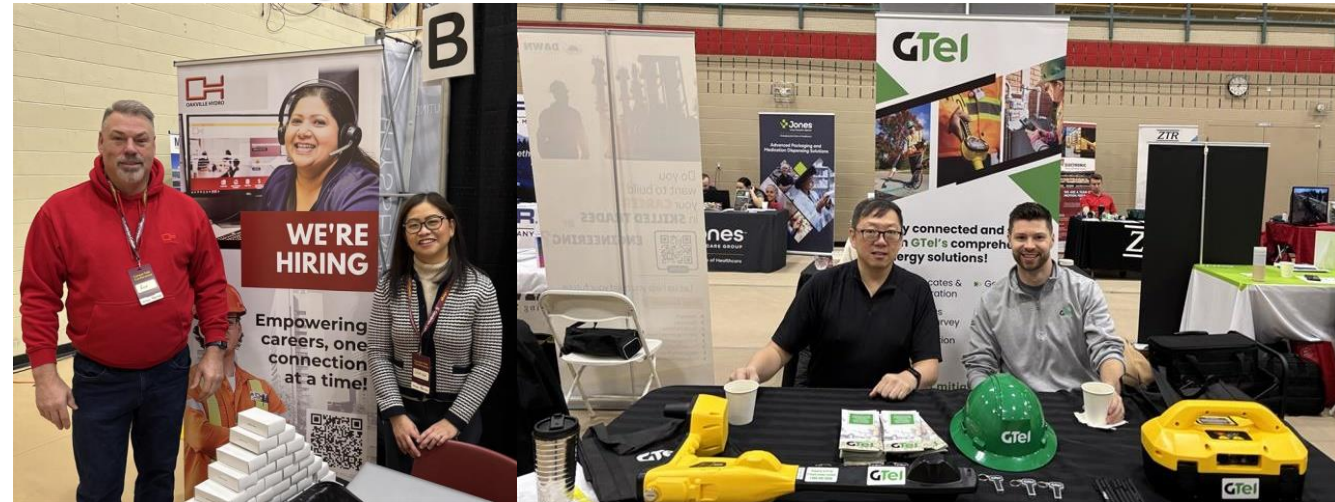
# Fostering Community Connections and Engagement
