An overview of previous studies or conversation that have taken place

- Kerr Village Revitalization Study 2008
- Economic Analysis and Retail Strategy for the Kerr Village BIA by the JC Williams Group 2015, through the Town of Oakville. Also included were streetscape ideas and suggestions.
- Kerr Village BIA Board interest in designated gateways and streetscape design has resulted in various meetings with Christina Tizzard Manager – Urban Design Town of Oakville.
- Recent participation with the authors of the Kerr Village Streetscape Study and attendance at the public meetings.
- Yearly meetings with the Town Horticulture Department regarding street beautification.



Kerr Village Streetscape Study

- Addition of gateways – six areas have been identified.
- Emphasis on bringing more people to the area by improving infrastructure and aesthetics, enhance Kerr Village's status as a tourist destination and welcoming area
- Need for new light poles and fixtures.
- Praise for the town's horticulture department, with a need for water sources for hanging baskets and barrels.
- Do not sacrifice parking availability it will be at a premium with the development of the area. Have a strong tie in with the transportation plan.
- Have streetscape conformity across the sixteen-mile creek bridge down Lakeshore Rd which includes Kerr Village to Bronte



Kerr Village Streetscape Study

- Desire for more uniform sidewalks and the transformation of Heritage Square back into green space from concrete.
- Suggestion to close Bond Street (relocate bus stop), turn into green space to increase park usage for events, leveraging its annual concert tradition.
- Find a solution to 3 major vacant lots along Kerr Street that have existed for well over a decade. Which could involve innovative streetscape plan.
