
## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2017-011**

A by-law to amend By-law 2002-153 (Anti-Idling By-law)

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend By-law 2002-153;

## **COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- **1.** By-law 2002-153, is hereby amended by:
  - **a.** deleting Definition 1(1) of "IDLE" and replacing the same with the following:
    - **IDLE** means the operation of the engine of a vehicle while the vehicle is parked or stopped and not being used to operate auxiliary equipment that is essential to the basic function of the vehicle and "idling" has a corresponding meaning
  - **b.** adding the Definition 1(3.1) the following:
    - **PARK, PARKED or PARKING -** means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers
  - **c.** adding the Definition 1(3.2) the following:
    - **STOP, STOPPED OR STOPPING** means the halting of a vehicle even momentarily, whether occupied or not except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions or a police officer, traffic control devise or traffic signal





**d.** deleting 2(1) and replacing the same with the following:

No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to idle for more than three (3) consecutive minutes
