The purpose of this email is to recommend that the nature of the reasons for any decision under Item 10 this evening be added to the decision of Council as adopted, regardless of whatever Decision is made.

So if Council, for example, accepts the Staff Recommendation of the Planning Services Department in the January 31, 2018 Report before Council in Item 10 this evening; then it is recommended that the nature of the reasons from the Report be included; namely <u>"be refused based on Town review of its heritage and planning merits."</u>
