- d. 66-70 Shepherd Road, currently designated by By-law 2009-079, a by-law to designate the Old Smith Houses at 531-533 Kerr Street as a property of historical, architectural and/or contextual significance; and
- e. 139 Thomas Street, currently designated by By-law 1995-122, a by-law to designate 139 Thomas Street (Old Radial Station) as a property of historical, architectural and contextual value and interest.
