As I'm sure you, traffic on Bronte and Rebecca is already too heavy and barely flows at all during rush hour.

I'm observing an increasing number of dangerous maneuvers by drivers heading south on Bronte where it drops to 1 southbound lane and also turning onto and off of Bridge.
