



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OAKVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-121

A by-law to amend By-law 2011-115, a by-law to delegate the power to consent/grant heritage permits for the alteration of designated heritage properties

COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 1 of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by adding the following section:
 - 1(d) with the agreement of the applicant, extend the 90-day timeline in which Council must make a decision on heritage permits for properties designated under Part IV and Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act* in accordance with sections 33.(5) and 42.(4) of the same *Act*.
2. Sections 2(c), 2(d), 2(e) and 2(f) of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 are amended by deleting the words “addition/removal” and replacing it with “addition/removal/replacement”.
3. Section 2(e) of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by deleting the word “exterior”.
4. Section 2(g) of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by deleting the words “removal/replacement” and replacing it with “addition/removal/replacement”.
5. Section 2 of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by deleting subsection 2(h) and replacing it with the following:

2(h) addition/removal/replacement of, or alterations to, detached single-storey accessory buildings or single-storey wings of a structure provided that the entire footprint of the accessory building or wing, including all open porches and spaces, is under 15 square metres (or 161 square feet);
6. Section 2 of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by deleting former subsection 2(i) and replacing it with the following:

2(i) minor revisions to previously approved heritage permits for works which are included in this Delegation By-law 2011-115;

7. Section 2 of the Town of Oakville Delegation By-law 2011-115 is amended by adding the following section:

2(k) severance of property made through a Consent Application under the Planning Act, provided that the application does not result in the creation of a new lot or development;
