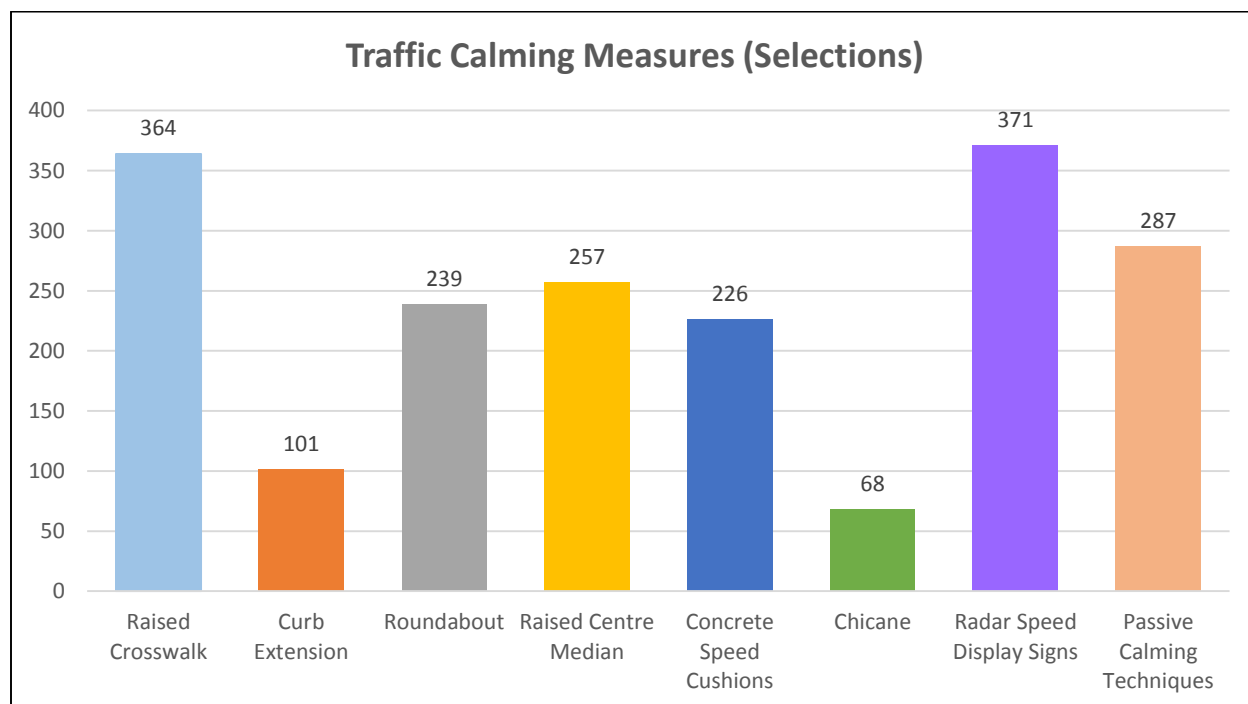


Appendix C – Traffic Calming Survey Results

Q1: Below are the eighth traffic calming measures that the town can implement. Please choose your three most preferred traffic calming measure.



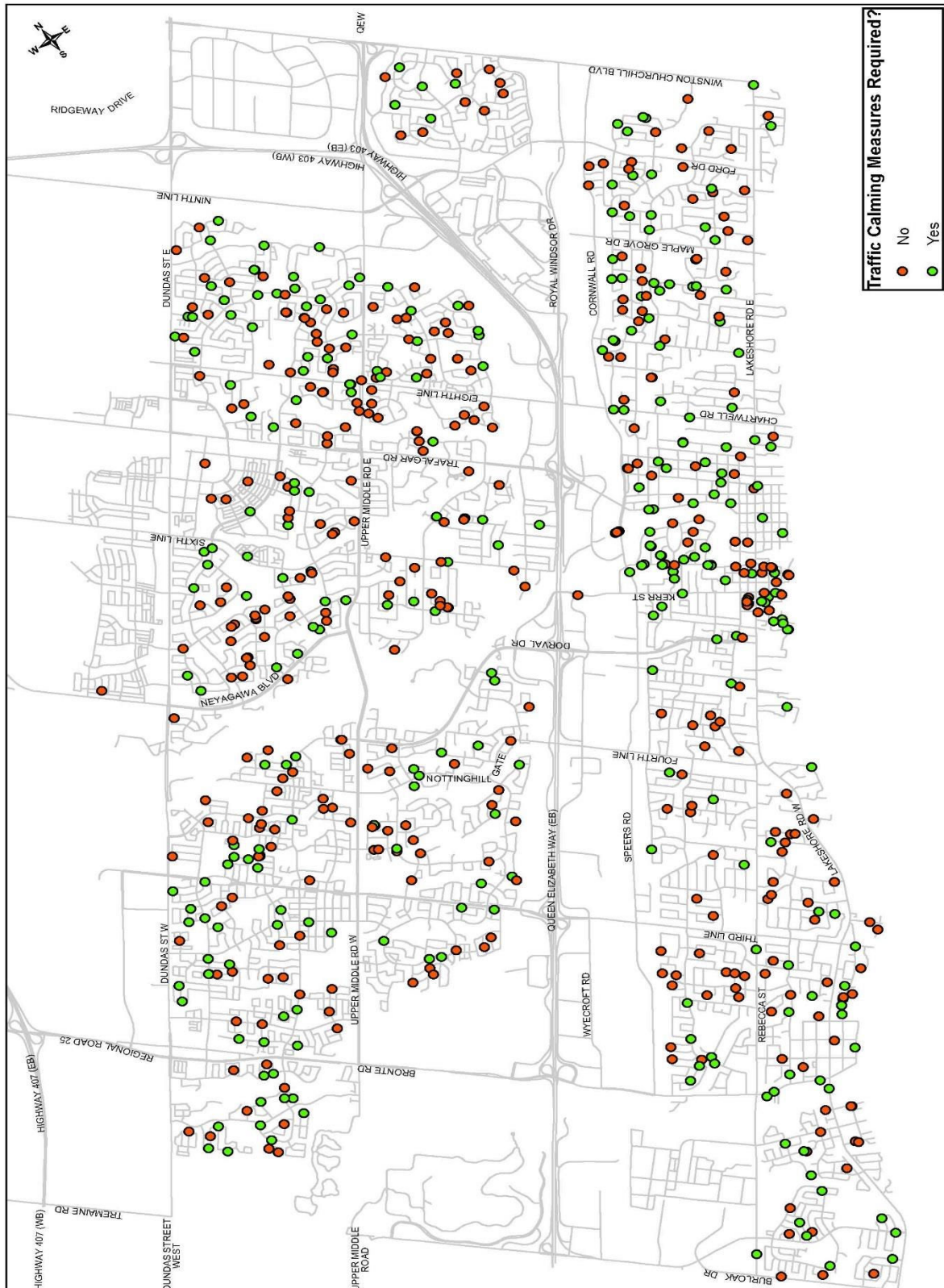
Q2: For each of the eighth traffic calming measures, tell us if you think they are suitable to implement across the town, in your neighbourhood or on your street.

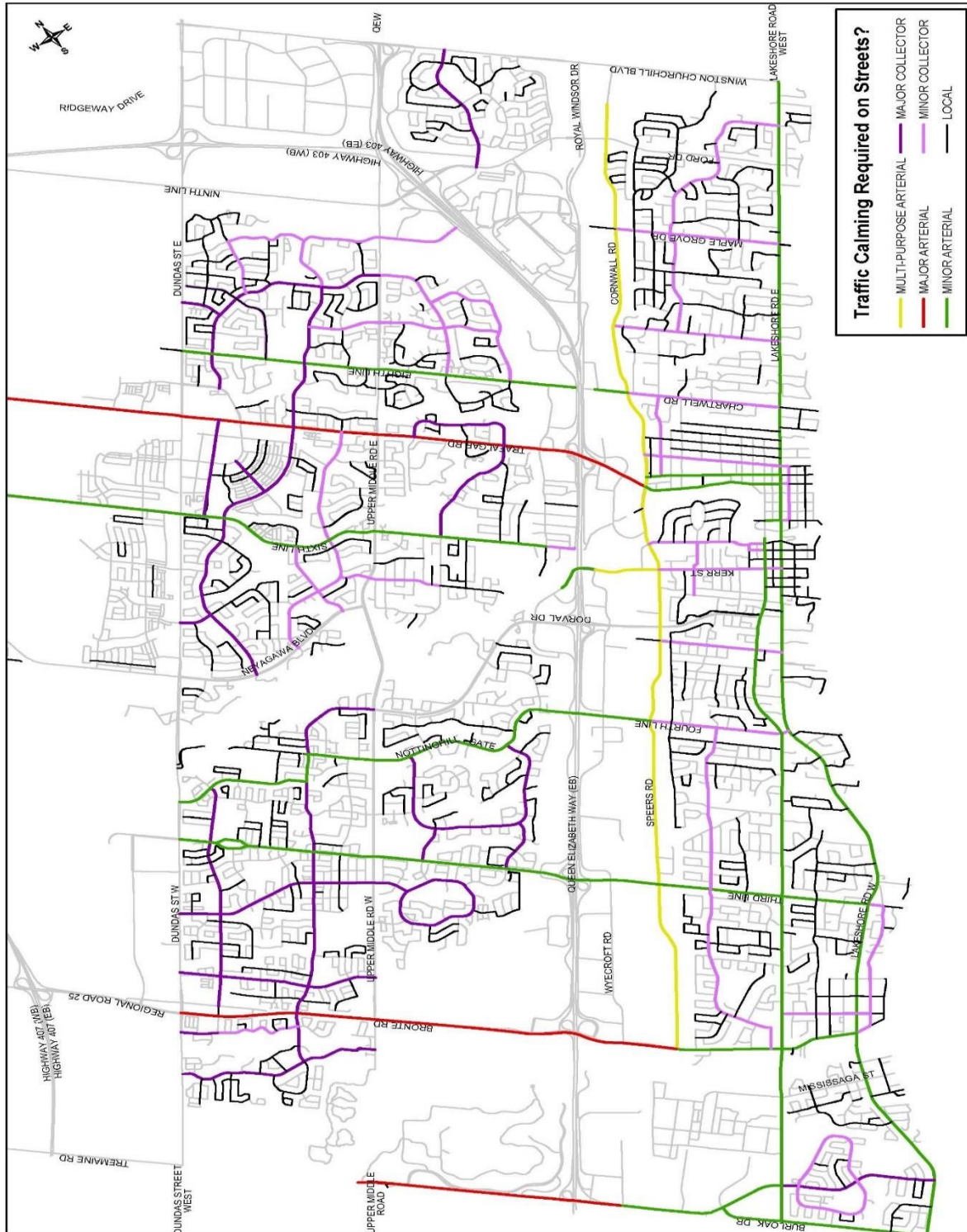
Q3: Do you think traffic calming measures are required on your street?
